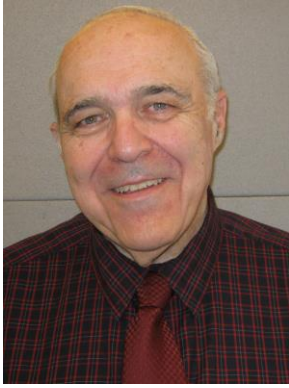
Randolph L. Snow, D.O., MBA, PhD

Charles J. Vacanti, M.D.

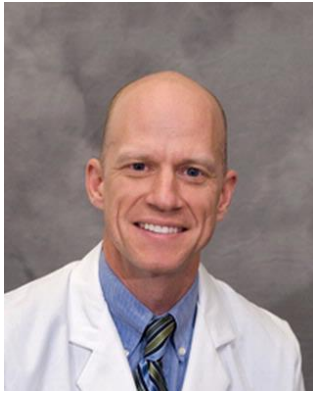

Dr. Steele and his wife, Amy, reside in Pittsford, NY and are proud parents of four children.



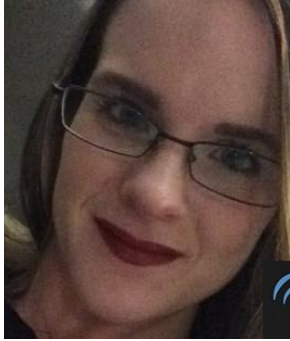
James R. Campbell, M.D.
